## **Road Safety Challenges in Greater Atlanta**

A recent study conducted in 2022 revealed that the greater Atlanta area is home to the top five most perilous roads in Georgia. High speeds make it challenging for drivers to control their vehicles safely, particularly on the multi-lane highways that crisscross the city. Moreover, higher speeds can result in more severe injuries in the event of an accident.

#### Measures to Improve Atlanta's Road Safety

In response to these road safety challenges, state and local government authorities have taken proactive steps to enhance safety for Atlanta's commuters. Considerable funding has been allocated to address the issues plaguing the city's streets, benefiting both residents and visitors.

- 1. **Pothole Repair:** Recognizing the hazards posed by potholes, the Atlanta Department of Transportation has established a dedicated team to promptly address these issues. In 2021 alone, more than 4,000 potholes were patched throughout Atlanta. - 2. Road Resurfacing: Beyond pothole repair, Atlanta is committed to addressing uneven road surfaces that challenge safe navigation. Plans are in place to completely resurface hazardous roads, promoting smoother travel and reduced safety risks. While resurfacing may necessitate temporary road closures and lane shutdowns, it is a critical strategy to prevent road deterioration over time, thereby ensuring safer conditions for Atlanta's drivers. The Atlanta DOT also aims to expand road infrastructure and address potential road-related issues, further enhancing the overall driving experience.
- 3. Increased Road Construction: Commuters in Atlanta can expect increased road construction activities as the Atlanta Department of Transportation strives to widen roads, enhance road smoothness, and improve overall travel conditions. While such construction may temporarily disrupt daily commutes, it will ultimately result in improved infrastructure that enhances road safety. Additional lanes and improved roads will help alleviate congestion issues that often plague Atlanta's streets due to inadequate infrastructure.
- 4. **Combating Drunk Driving:** In tandem with infrastructure improvements, the Atlanta Police Department has intensified efforts to identify and apprehend intoxicated drivers. Particularly during the summer months, the police department deploys targeted traffic stops and checkpoints to detect and remove drunk drivers from the road, thereby enhancing driver safety. The presence of these checkpoints can also serve as a deterrent, discouraging individuals from driving under the influence and promoting responsible decision-making.
